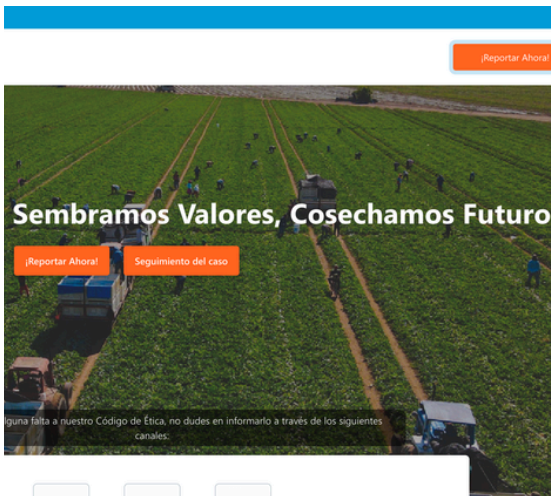


HEALTH FAIR BENEFITS MORE THAN 300 PEOPLE AT MONTELÍBANO FARM

Through this alliance, the Becas Tutoría program will continue to be implemented in 14 educational centers, benefiting 375 students with the support of 75 tutors who provide academic assistance in key subjects such as Spanish and mathematics.

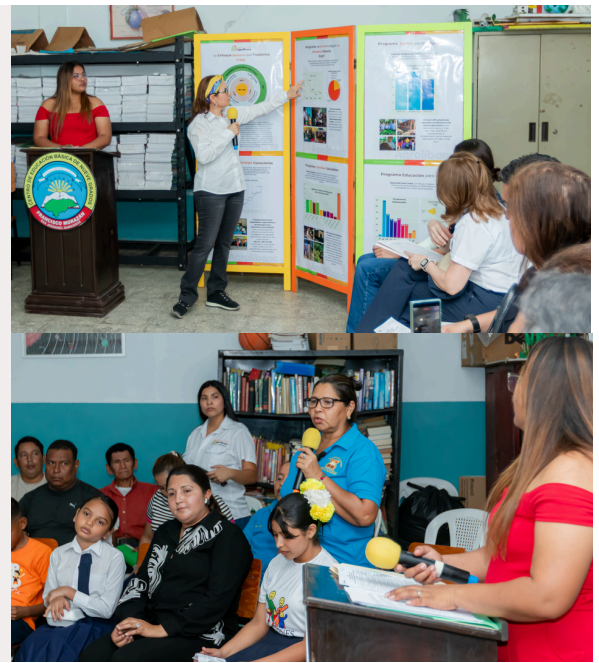

This initiative is part of a strategic alliance of more than a decade between both foundations and is integrated into the Juntos por la Educación program, aimed at improving educational conditions in the region.

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
